- Make certain your affirmation is positive and in the here and now - I'm extremely wealthy and famous, NOT I'll be wealthy and famous
- Only work with 1 or 2 affirmations at a time, to let your brain absorb the message
- Write up the affirmation twenty times in the morning and at night
- State your affirmation aloud to yourself in the mirror
- If you're having a negative thought, say your affirmation to yourself
- Keep your affirmations brief and particular
- Sing them aloud, in the automobile, in the shower, in the bathtub!



- State them with emotion and passion, and a big grin on your face
- Don't throw in the towel! To successfully reprogramme your subconscious mind you have to repeat your affirmations each day, ideally morning, noon and night

As a lot of individuals have observed, "Success leaves clues." If you wish to accomplish extraordinary success in your life, study the experts, accomplish what they accomplish, and modify their strategies to suit your certain situation. there are basic principles. In the belief that we all have to be reminded of them on a regular basis, here are a few of the secrets that have helped me over the years:

- Center on values. I've known individuals who made some cash and gotten fame, but I've never known anybody who got rich and famous without analyzing their own values, priorities and notions. Begin by putting down a list of things you value, things you trust, what you wish, and what you plan to do with this unbelievable life you have. Begin with your values.
- Have a life. Before you are able to handle great wealth and fame, you have to make room for it. This is the old, "if you build it, they will come" way of thinking. Attempting to squeeze success, wealth, fame or fortune into a little life won't work out. Make a life first; the life-style of your dreams will come after.

- Do away with clutter. Attempting to create success and accomplish wealth while your life is a wreck won't work. Success calls for clear-cut priorities and a passionate committedness. Simplify your life. Do away with the excuses. Clean up everything that distracts you from accomplishing your most crucial goals.
- Nail down your results. Nobody will hit a target they can't see. Specify your outcomes and set clear-cut, accomplishable results beforehand. Understand what "success" looks like! Have measurable, particular outcomes and determine that you'll achieve them!
- Set your ships on fire. There's an ancient story about a Greek general who set ashore on an enemy beach, then set his ships on fire. He wanted to make it really clear: withdraw and failure weren't an option! Leave no room for being an unsuccessful person.
- Put in more than you extract. No one will pay you more than your services are worth! even if you are famous Get clear about this! You just can't fool individuals very long. Your services and your results have to be far more useful than the fee you charge. Some individuals will rip you off; the rest will make you wealthy!
- Live below what you can truly afford. Rich individuals understand this. Wealth is amassed, re-invested, utilized wisely

and given away. It's never squandered! If you want to achieve great wealth, live simply, invest wisely, enjoy it all!

- Get rich slowly. The key to excellent wealth is to minimize income, while maximizing your assets. Revenue is taxed. Revenue gets spent -- consider all the cars, boats, diamonds and houses individuals with huge incomes like to purchase! Investing in assets that are difficult to spend (buildings, stocks and bonds, collectible art, and so forth) produces wealth that is not taxed, and isn't spent on a chance impulse.
- Give some away. You can't take it with you when you pass away, and cash isn't attracted to the selfish, the miserly or the mean. If you'd attract cash to your life, be clear about what you wish to do with it. Contribute to charities that will utilize it for good. Make the world a better, more plentiful place and you'll produce wealth that will last for generations to come. Your youngsters will thank you!
